Voice I and II instructor: Lisa Matsko Hamilton earned an MFA in Music Theatre at University of California, Irvine, and has also studied at the University of Redlands and Syracuse University.

Hanke, a nationally renowned master class instructor who is known for his performance as Tom Sawyer in the DeafWest/ Roundabout national tour of *Big River*. More recently he has been seen on Broadway as Bud Frump in *How to Succeed...*, Mark in *Rent*, Baldwin in *Cry Baby*, and JT in *My Life*. A popular instructor, Hanke has served on the faculty at Texas State University.

Bring a one to two-minute prepared monologue from a published play or sheet music in the correct key. Accompanist provided.
